# EXPLORE EUGENE DURING THE SUNNY SEASON

here's nothing quite like spring and summer in Eugene. The sun finally emerges from behind the clouds and gives us opportunities to play outside. Lush greenery and vibrant flowers fill our strolls through town. And, most importantly, people are out and about, giving us plenty of social avenues.

During spring and into summer, Eugene is full of street fairs and outdoor festivals designed to bring people together and experience Eugene's unique culture. Artists, food trucks, and small businesses gather together at these events to show off their products; some even include free samples. Don't miss the **Eugene Saturday Market**, an event that will immerse any visitor in true Eugene culture.

Restaurants will often open their outdoor seating areas to give people a new dining experience that is so often closed to Oregonians. Explore some of Eugene's coolest restaurants and bask in the enjoyment of the sunshine. Eat some exquisite cafe-style food at **Café 440**, or try some hearty Mexican food at **Chapala**. Or, grab some **Track Town Pizza** to go, and make any park your own outdoor eatery.

Famous for its craft beer, Eugene breweries always create new flavors to match the season. Moving into summer, expect both major and up-and-coming breweries to experiment with warm-weather styles. Visit some Eugene staple breweries, like Falling Sky Brewing and Hop Valley. Or, journey a little ways into the country to taste some farm-fresh beer at Agrarian Ales Brewing Co. If you can't decide which brewery you want to explore, visit a taphouse and see what brewery selections they feature.

The Willamette Valley's famous wineries open up their properties when the sun comes out as well. Spend a sunny afternoon tasting

Eugene's tradition Pinot Noirs or their summertime experiments while surrounded by Oregon's natural beauty. Hayworth Estate Wines, J. Scott Cellars, and Territorial Vineyards, Capitello, and Eugene Wine Cellars offer some trendy tasting rooms within close proximity, while King Estate provides an expansive vineyard environment. Visit any (or all) of the Eugene area vineyards and sample Oregon fame.

Spend a sunny Oregon morning sitting outside with a freshly brewed coffee or tea at one of Eugene quaint cafes. Sit at a table along a bustling sidewalk and watch the world go by in total relaxation.

Eugene features plenty of inexpensive-yet-exciting events that will provide opportunities to socialize and experience the city's culture. University of Oregon spring sports come into full swing. Catch a track event at the historic Hayward Field, a baseball game at PK Park, a softball game right on campus, or a lacrosse game near Autzen Stadium.

The sun tends to draw summertime concerts and live events. Matthew Knight Arena brings some major headliners, while venues like McDonald Theatre and WOW Hall provide intimate atmospheres. For more live performances, check out theater venues, like Rose Children's Theater.

On a sunny Eugene day, it can be hard to stay inside. Luckily, the Eugene area contains some incredible natural adventure spots. Spend a few hours hiking up Spencer's Butte or Mount Pisgah, which both stand a short drive away from the University of Oregon campus. Or, stroll along the Willamette River and enjoy the lush Oregon vegetation. The Eugene area features plenty of waterfall hikes as well. Venture to Wildwood Falls and have a picnic, or trek through the forests around Oakridge to check out a series of small waterfalls and lakes in the Willamette National Forest.

Eugene is also one of the most cycling friendly cities in the country. Experience the city's miles and miles of cycling trails that bring riders along scenic rivers and through dense forests.

Oakridge features some of Oregon's most adventurous mountain biking terrain. Life Cycle

Bike Shop provides amateur and avid cyclists and mountain bikers with gear and information for a successful adventure.

Spring and summer in Eugene can provide some of the most memorable experiences of the entire year.

Get outside and explore all of the opportunities that the city and the University of Oregon campus provide. Make this sunny season its own adventure!

# **Mental Mansion** Escape Rooms Think Your Way Out

am a 36-year-old stay-at-home dad/small business owner. My wife is an ICU nurse and we have been together for over seven years. I graduated from the University of Oregon in 2011 with a bachelor's degree in Business Administration with a concentration in Finance.

I first experienced an escape room in 2015 in Portland with my in-laws. I was so excited by the whole experience that I knew I needed to create one of my own. I wanted to give people what I felt while bringing them closer together with the people around them. It feels like we have too much disconnect in our lives. We need more positive experiences that will pull us back together. So, after nine months of convincing my wife and crafting a business plan, she finally agreed to let me try.

We started in 2016 as an 8x8 pop-up booth at the Eugene Saturday Market to test-run our escape room in the Eugene/Springfield area. After the summer was over, we secured funding and started looking for a permanent location. We found the Meridian Building on the corner of 18th and Willamette. We knew it was the right fit for us, so we moved in and started construction in the summer of 2017. By September of 2017, we opened our doors to the public with our first experience: "The Albino Elephant". Now, we have two experiences for people to enjoy: "The Albino Elephant" and "Mayhem on the Menu."





#### BETWEEN FARM AND TABLE

ver wonder how local restaurants are able to buy the freshest ingredients, or how farms supply their produce all over the state? Many use produce suppliers to work between farms and stores. The only produce supplier in the Eugene, Springfield area is Emerald Fruit and Produce Co.

Since 1962, Emerald Fruit and Produce Co. has been providing farm fresh produce to the local community. They're responsible for buying fresh produce from farmers and then fulfill orders to local restaurants, schools, hospitals, caterers and more.

Kyle Herbert, son of the owner Denis Herbert, said "We do same day deliveries here. A lot of places don't do that, you've got to call the day before. If a restaurant calls at nine in the morning, we can have their stuff to them by noon."

The process of buying and selling fresh produce is a balancing act. Emerald Fruit and Produce Co. has to estimate the amount of produce they will need to purchase and supply to local businesses. If they have too much of a product it may go bad; too little and they will run out.

"It's such a fast-paced thing," Kyle said. "You've got to buy day to day. You know, you can't buy something for a month's worth because it will go bad on you."

Emerald Fruit and Produce Co. has been a family owned business since it opened in the early 1960s. It is well-established in the food service industry as a produce supplier that tries to provide the freshest ingredients for the local community. So ask your local businesses where they get their produce; if it's Emerald Fruit and Produce Co., you'll know that it's fresh.


"People come in here because they like to feel the season," Sunderland said.


